



Graduate Credit for InTech

Participants wishing to obtain graduate credit *in lieu of SDU credit* for InTech must follow the guidelines below:

1. Participants must be currently enrolled in the University of Georgia Graduate School.
2. Once enrolled in the University of Georgia Graduate School, participants must register for a special course. The course number and name will be provided upon request when you are ready to register. See below for contact information.

Admittance to the University of Georgia Graduate School may be accomplished in one of three ways:

- Regular Admission to obtain a degree
- Non-Degree (ND) – Participants who do not intend to pursue a degree but who wish to take courses for professional advancement, licensure, or certification purposes, and who hold a baccalaureate degree or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution, should apply for Non-Degree status. Participants must submit the following: general application for admission, application – processing fee, two official copies of transcripts, and a statement of purpose. For the Major/Degree Objective data field, you should choose – Instructional Technology (ND).
- Graduate Transient (TRANS) – Transient admission may be granted to students in good standing at a regionally accredited graduate school who wish to enroll for one semester at the University of Georgia. If you are currently enrolled in another regionally accredited graduate school, but wish to get graduate credit for InTech, you would apply as a Transient student. Participants must submit the following: general application for admission, an application – processing fee, and certification of graduate standing in a regionally accredited institution. For the Major/Degree Objective data field, you should choose – Instructional Technology (TRANS).

To begin the admission process:

- Click on Admissions to complete the requirements.

Cost for admission and registration:

1. The application-processing fee of \$30.00 in the form of check or money order must accompany the application for admission.
2. Cost of InTech course, which is 3 semester hours, is approximately \$375.00.
