Applicants must be within two semesters of graduation and enrolled in a field placement experience during the semester they participate in the Bridges program.

Students applying for the Bridges program must agree to:

- Attend six days of Initial training sessions for a total of 45 contact hours (8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m.). This training will occur during one semester. Specific dates will be coordinated through your department.
- Critically examine their own instructional practices to determine how technology can play a role in enhancing the teaching and learning process.
- Design and implement four technology connected lessons and activities with appropriate grade level students during the training program.
- Purchase an Instructional/Resource Manual from the Technology Center for \$75.00.
