Technology Bridges Fall 2007

This Fall the UGA ETTC will again teach Building Technology Bridges in Education for UGA Early Childhood Education students in their student-teaching semester. This intense 6 day course focuses on preparing pre-service teachers for teaching 21st Century students. Students are required to teach and reflect on at least six technology connected activities using tools such as student response devices, wireless slates, and visual presenters.
